



## Homebrew Dipole Mounting

I use a “T” in the middle for **vertical** use to pull the coax straight out on to avoid interference of being too close to the antenna (the mast, should be non-conductive, can also come off the end with a 90 degree ell if used **vertically**). The wing nuts are for the coax connections. If mounted **vertical**, the coax center conductor must be connected to the top pipe. For **horizontal** use, it doesn't matter which connection goes where, and conductive masts can be used. EMT conduit and wire works too- just support by top wire and let hang down.
