

Homebrew Dipole Mounting

I use a "T" in the middle for vertical use to pull the coax straight out on to avoid interference of being too close to the antenna (the mast, should be non-conductive, can also come off the end with a 90 degree ell if used vertically). The wing nuts are for the coax connections. If mounted vertical, the coax center conductor must be connected to the top pipe. For horizontal use, it doesn't matter which connection goes where, and conductive masts can be used. EMT conduit and wire works

too-just support by top wire and let hang down.
